# CV – MEDINA DUGGER (b. Corpus Christi, Texas)

Medina Dugger is an artist from California who studied at Spéos Photographic Institute in Paris, France (2010). She's been based between Lagos, Nigeria and California since 2011. She works in different artistic mediums including photography, collage, painting and video. Medina's thematic practice has been greatly shaped by the years she's spent in Lagos and on the African continent. Her work focuses on themes both contemporary and timeless including style, the female form, acculturation, ethnocentrism, cultural homogenization, indigenous practices, globalization, identity, tradition, modernity and imagination. She also aims to undermine negative stereotypes and minimizing storylines common to Nigeria and Africa. Her work has been exhibited internationally including Untitled Miami, the Investec Cape Town Art Fair and featured in Vogue, Smithsonian Magazine, CNN Africa, BBC News among other publications and has been collected by General Mills Private Art Collection and Fondation Zinsou.

Before turning her attention to her artistic practice, Medina spent 4 years in Lagos working as a project coordinator/curator for the African Artists' Foundation and co-curator for the LagosPhoto Festival (2011-2015) organizing the foundation and festival programming. In 2015 Medina began creative consulting as photo editor and social media manager for Moon Man Studios, a concept studio in London that specializes in innovative art direction and creative production. In 2018, Medina co-founded ARTOJA, an online marketplace and creative production company for contemporary art and design in Africa.

Medina is currently represented by Art Twenty One in Lagos in Lagos and SoArt Gallery in Morocco.
